# RATE SCHEDULE AL-1 PRIVATE AREA LIGHTING ELECTRIC SERVICE

### Availability of Service

Hancock Wood Electric Cooperative, Inc. (HWE) has lighting service available to its customers.

This service is available to customers, other than municipalities, townships, counties, subdivision associations, and other governmental entities, for automatically controlled dusk-to-dawn outdoor lighting where existing overhead secondary circuits are located. This service is available in all territories served.

## Type of New Service

Service under this rate schedule shall be alternating current 60 Hertz, single phase at HWE's standard voltages and shall include lamp renewals and automatically controlled energy from approximately dusk each day until approximately dawn the following day.

Lighting will be with high pressure sodium (HPS) or light-emitting diode (LED) light fixtures mounted on existing wooden pole, where applicable, with bracket attachment and connected to existing overhead secondary circuit.

## Monthly Rates for Service

HWE rates for service are based on the type of service and installation and monthly charges shall include any applicable tax(s) or power cost adjustment.

All service under Schedule AL-1 is subject to the provisions of this schedule and to HWE's General Terms & Conditions and any subsequent revisions thereof.

## Power Cost Adjustment

The amount computed at the above rate shall be adjusted plus or minus by an amount calculated in accordance with the formula specified in HWE.'s power cost adjustment clause which is part of this rate schedule.

## Tax Adjustment

The amount computed at the above monthly rate as adjusted by the application of HWE's power cost adjustment clause shall be subject to taxes, assessments, and surcharges imposed by any governmental authority calculated in accordance with HWE's tax adjustment clause which is a part of this rate schedule.

#### Terms of Service

- 1. The term of service under this schedule is not less than five years. If HWE is required to remove or replace private area light facilities provided under this schedule, for any reason, forcing premature retirement, the Customer shall be required to pay HWE an amount equal to the original installed cost, less depreciation and salvage value, plus the cost of removal.
- 2. HWE shall furnish, install, operate, and maintain the outdoor lighting equipment including lamp, luminaire, bracket attachment, and control device, electrically connected so that the power for operation of the light does not pass through the customer's meter.

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- 3. Lighting equipment shall be installed at a location mutually agreeable to HWE and the customer.
- 4. HWE shall maintain the lighting equipment, including lamp replacement, at no additional cost to the customer within five scheduled workdays after the customer notifies HWE of the need for maintenance of the lighting equipment.
- 5. The lighting equipment shall remain the property of HWE. The customer shall reimburse HWE for the cost of maintenance which is caused by vandalism or damages as a direct result of customer's actions.
- 6. Customer shall allow authorized representatives of HWE to enter upon the customer's premises and to trim trees and shrubs as necessary for maintenance of the lighting equipment and for removal of the lighting equipment upon termination of service under this schedule.
- 7. HWE, while exercising diligence at all times in furnishing service hereunder, does not guarantee continuous lighting and will not be liable for damages from any interruption, deficiency, or failure of service and reserves the right to interrupt service at any time for necessary repairs to lines or equipment or for system protection.
- 8. Should an objection be made to the placement of a lighting facility by someone other than the Customer and Customer cannot resolve the objection, HWE reserves the right to remove or relocate the lighting fixture or terminate the service.
- 9. The above rates are net. In the event the current bill is not paid after due notice, to the extent permitted by law, the customer is subject to a latepayment charge and disconnection.
- 10. Installation of lighting equipment on approved structures and extension of overhead and/or underground service to area lighting is subject to the provisions of this schedule and to HWE's Electric Distribution and Services Extension Policy or subsequent revisions thereof.
- 11. HWE reserves the right to retire high pressure sodium and mercury vapor light fixtures and provide a suitable LED type replacement as determined by HWE.

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
